_____ AND TO HAVE THE RIGHT TO EXEMPTION FROM THE
TOURIST TAX PURSUANT TO ART. 5 OF THE MUNICIPAL REGULATION AS A:

- Children under the age of 16
- Subject that lodges following measures adopted by public authorities
- Subject carrying out emergency voluntary work following calamities
- Coach driver or tourist guide (the exemption applies to each coach driver and one guide for every 25 participants)
- Personnel belonging to the State police and other armed forces
- University students regularly enrolled in one of the Brescia-based faculties and Erasmus students
- Employee of the management of the accommodation facility
- Subject who is staying for more than 90 days in the calendar year in the same accommodation facility

The undersigned has rendered the above declarations, choices and information in full awareness of the penal sanctions provided for acts of duplicity and false declarations, as foreseen by article 76 of DPR 445/2000, and is aware that untruthful declarations shall disqualify him/her for the benefits of the measure being issued on the basis of the declaration, as foreseen by article 75 of DPR 445/2000.

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With regard to personal data (referred to as “natural persons”) processed by the Sector pursuant to articles 13-14 of Reg. EU 2016/679 we inform users that:

- the data controller is the Municipality of Brescia, based in Brescia in Piazza della Loggia n. 1, represented with regard to privacy obligations by the General Manager - contact data direzionegenerale@comune.brescia.it
- contact details of the data protection officer RPD@comune.brescia.it
- the Municipality may use third parties (identified as data processors) on the basis of a contract or other legal act for the personal data processing
- personal data are processed for the institutional purposes assigned to the Municipality and processing is necessary for the execution of public interest functions or connected to the exercise of public authority; the offices only acquire the mandatory data for the start-up and conclusion of the administrative procedures
- processing takes place both on paper / manual and electronic / IT tools
- processing is carried out in compliance with legal or regulatory provisions to fulfill the obligations and the faculties of local authorities
- the following categories of data are treated: data related to the application of the tourist tax
- the processed data can be transmitted to the following categories of subjects: financial administration
- automated decision-making processes are not adopted that involve the adoption of decisions on people are not adopted, not even profiling
- the communication of data to third parties takes place on the basis of laws or regulations, and in order to be able to provide institutional services and to be able to start and complete the administrative procedures required by the law
- the data is stored for the duration envisaged by current legislation on the storage of data / paper / digital documents of the public administration
- failure to provide data to the Municipality, refusal to respond or failure to acquire data may make it impossible for the administrative procedure concerned to be completed and terminated and for the service to be provided
- personal data processing is based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency, respecting the confidentiality of the data subjects
- data subjects (the natural persons to whom the personal data refer) have the right to access the data, to the rectification, to the limitation or opposition to the processing for legitimate and expressed reasons, to present a complaint to the Privacy Authority
- the processed data are purchased by the data subjects or by third parties, always in compliance with the regulations and the institutional purposes of the treatments
- the publication of personal data takes place in the cases and with the limits established by current legislation
